6. Management work at the Knowledge Network Institute of Thailand (KNIT)

1. Design and organize training courses for higher education capacity building

- 1) **University Good Governance programme (UGP).** This training course was designed for university council chairman, university council board member, president and the secretariat to provide knowledge and share experiences on roles of the university council board members so that they can do their work efficiently and effectively which would then benefit the universities and the country as a whole. The first class was opened in 2008 and still on demand till now.
- 2) **Deans for Change (DFC)** The target group for this course was the middle management level in higher education institutions e.g. vice-presidents, assistant to the presidents, deans, vice deans, directors, etc. The aim of this course was to equip the participants with relevant knowledge, skills, and management tools so that they can change or revise something (process or policy) in their workplace. This course lasted 3 months and comprised 3 main modules, namely, 1) learn and share which took one week in Thailand, 2) study visit to universities abroad, e.g. Germany, Australia for a week and 3) Project Action Plan where each participants had to propose a project to change something on their current work to make it better. This course run from 2009-2016.
- 3) **Conflict Management programme.** The target group was president, vice president, assistant to the presidents, deans, vice dean, directors, vice-director, etc in a university. This course aimed to enhance knowledge and skills on conflict management in a university setting. It would open 1st first class on 2017.

2. Organise series of seminar on university missions, each topics were organized 1-2 times a year

1) **Seminar series on “Thai University in the World Stage”** where 22 topics were organized since 2010-2014, e.g OECD and Trends of Higher Education, University Ranking, University Reform, University and Regional Development, University Professional Development, University and Social Enterprise, Learning Outcomes, Course Redesign และ University Governance. Each topic comprised international speakers from around the world, e.g. France, UK, USA, Canada, Netherlands, Sweden, Poland, Germany, etc and local speakers which attracted over 120 participants in each seminar.

2) **Seminar series on Innovation in Teaching and Learning** which included workshop and round-table meeting in the related topics

3) **Seminar series on “From Green University to Sustainable Campus”** which included workshop and round-table meeting in the related topics.

4) **Seminar series on “University Engagement”** which led to the creation of the Engagement Thailand Network.
