Immediate benefits from ACI

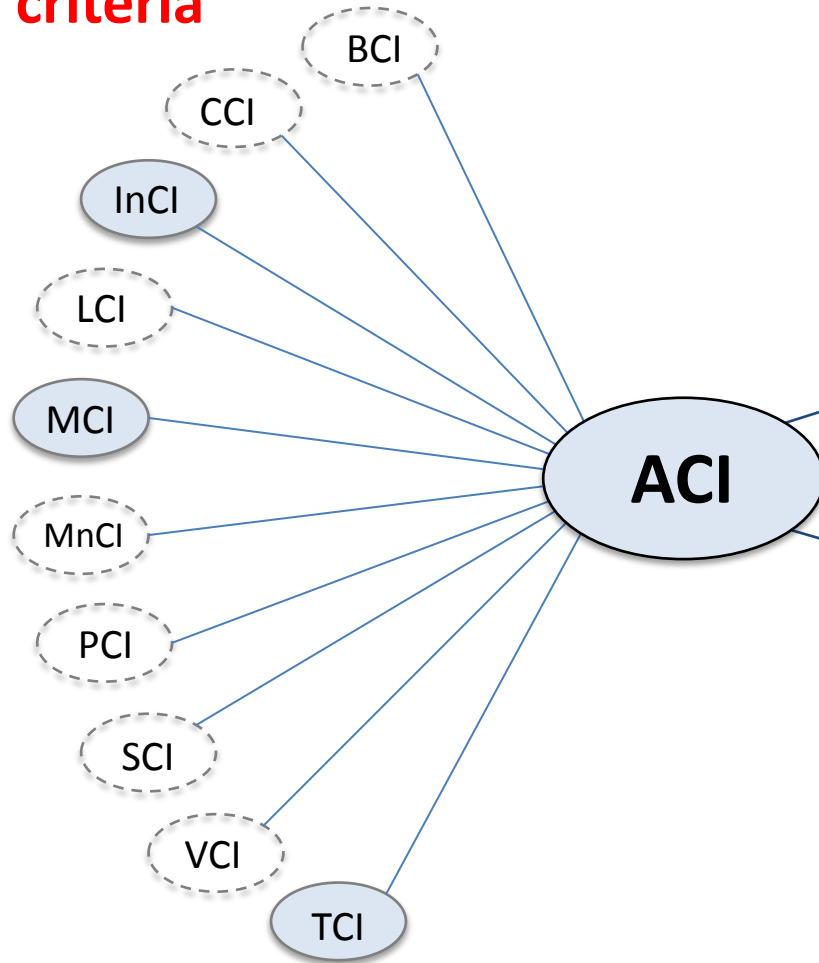


- Our own regional database.

- Integrations of performance evaluation levels (national, regional and international).

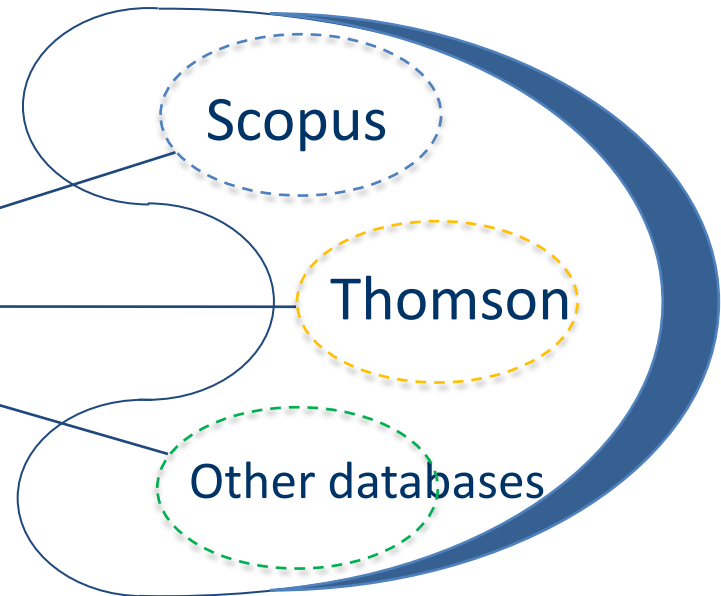

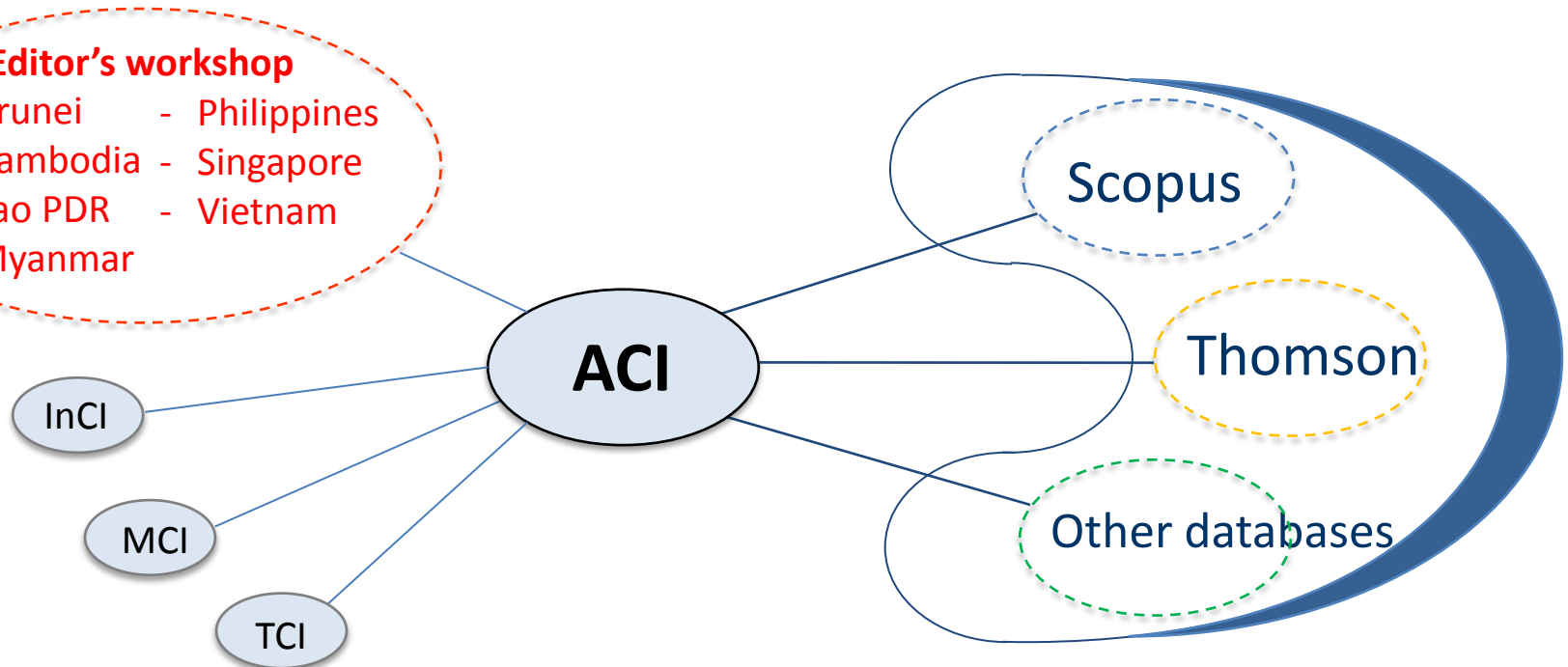
