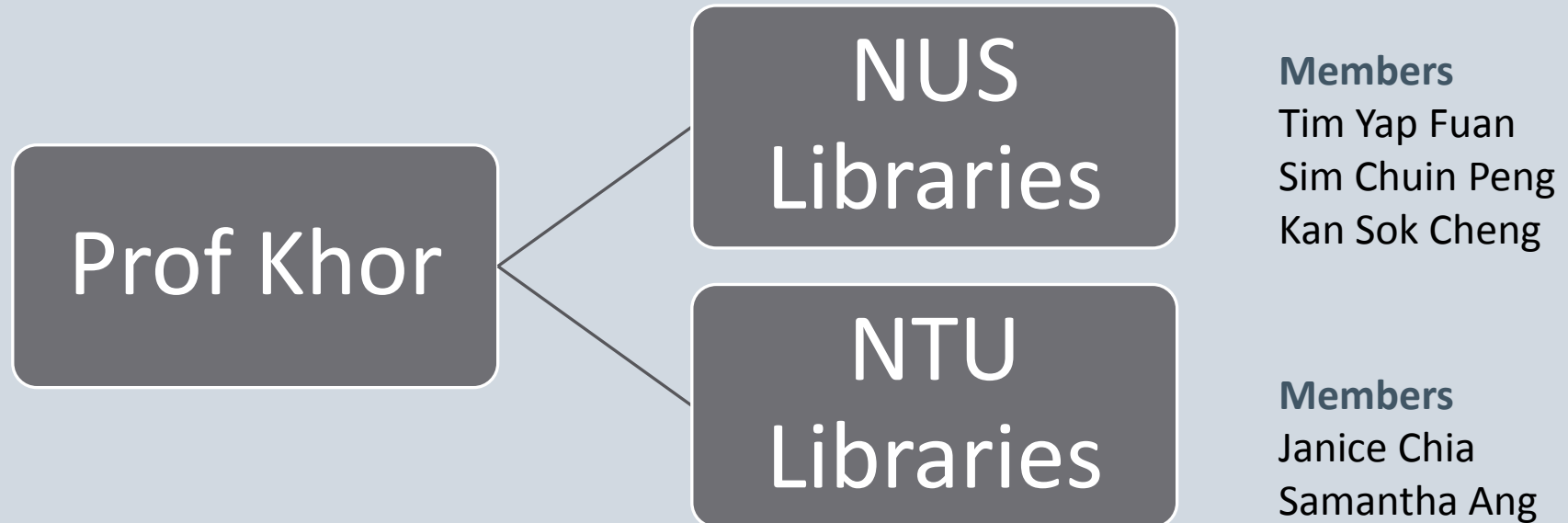


ASEAN CITATION INDEX

PROGRESS REPORT : SINGAPORE

ACI – SINGAPORE WORKING TEAM

The ACI Singapore working team was formed in 2014 and is chaired by Prof Michael Khor, Singapore representative to the ASEAN Citation Index Steering Committee.



SCOPE OF WORK

1. Identify journals published in Singapore for inclusion in the ASEAN Citation Index as Singapore does not have a National Citation Index.
2. Establish selection criteria and shortlist titles.
3. Contact the respective editors / publishers to request for permission to include the journal in ACI.
4. Facilitate communication between the respective journal editors and ACI on matters arising.

JOURNAL SELECTION

Selection criteria include :

1. Key metadata of articles and cited references must be in English
2. Articles are peer-reviewed
3. Journal has a regional focus / scope
4. Timeliness of publication

SHORTLISTING PROCESS

We identified 20 journals from different disciplines / subjects and proceeded to contact their respective editors / publishers :
