



**Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi

The Opening of KMUTT

With reference to the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on the Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 16 regarding the temporary closure of KMUTT from September 4-7, 2020, by virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi ACT B.E.2541, the university therefore has issued the announcement to resume the operation with the following detailed actions and steps to be taken:

1. All study areas of the university are now open.
2. Concerned about the wellbeing of the students and staff of KMUTT, the university urges that the students and staff members living at Ban Suanthon Condominium, Phuttabucha Road, Bangmod, which are regarded as a risk area; strictly comply with the preventive measures of COVID-19 for the safety of themselves and public. Both undergraduate and graduate students are requested to take online classes (lectures, demonstration and other types of multimedia). In addition, for staff, it is at the discretion of supervisors to assign their team members to work at the office or from home until September 17, 2020.
3. Students or staff who have a fever or experience respiratory abnormalities or anticipate COVID-19 patient/case(s) are requested to report the Department or immediate superiors, fill out a "Report of anticipating COVID-19 patient at KMUTT" at bit.ly/Wereport and visit health service providers according to their benefit scheme.

If there is any problem or issue arising from this announcement, President, Senior Vice President for Administrative Affairs and Director of Office of Building and Ground Management are tasked with deliberating and executing any action deemed appropriate.
