

Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 18

Closing and disinfecting KMUTT Bang Khun Thian

The university was notified by a student from Media Arts and Technology Program who lives at Ban Suanthon Condominium, Phuttabucha Road, Bangmod that the student had attended the class at Building A1, Bang Khun Thian Campus and had a high fever on September 10, 2020 and was already admitted to Bang Khun Thian Geriatric Hospital for treatment and examination. Since the result will be reported on September 11, 2020, in order to comply with the safety measure and the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 17, by virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Act B.E. 2541, the university has thus issued the announcement with the following steps to be taken:

- 1. Building A1 of KMUTT Bang Khun Thian is closed for cleaning and disinfection on September 11, 2020.
- 2. Students and staff who have been exposed to or in close contact with the student with high fever are requested to strictly observe the measures to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 for safety of themselves and the public. The university asks the students to take online courses and staff members to work from home until September 17, 2020.
- 3. Students or staff members who have a fever or experience respiratory abnormalities are requested to report the Department or immediate superiors by filling out "a Report of anticipating COVID-19 patient at KMUTT" at bit.ly/Wereport and visiting health service providers according to their benefit scheme.

The student from the Media Arts and Technology Program has followed the procedure of Ministry of Public Health on the COVID-19 testing. The university will keep everyone updated in the future.
