

Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 8

Assistance for employees of university's contractors

The Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak has been continued since January 2020. To ensure orderliness and effective operation as well as safety during the crisis, the university has therefore announced the followings by virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Act, B.E. 2541.

- 1. The services of security officers and cleaning service providers are to be continued as usual. They are requested to comply with the measures and surveillance of outbreak of the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) of the University. Contractors of the university can arrange a schedule to allow their employees to take turns to work any day in the week (to cover seven days) to prevent them from gathering in groups and to practice social distancing.
- 2. In case the workers are under a 14-day self-quarantine as requested by the university, they shall be entitled to receive a full wage from the company.
- 3. The companies must stress and ensure that their employees avoid visiting risky areas or crowded areas where there are large crowds of people. If non-compliance is reported, the university will request a replacement worker and will ignore No.2.
- 4. In the event of No. 2, the university will continue the operation with the remaining manpower. Except when more workers are needed, the university shall discuss with the contractors about increasing the number of workers. Additional costs will then be compensated by the university.
