

Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 9

Extension of Temporary Closure of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi

Recently, Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) has issued the announcement to temporarily close the venues (No. 4) on March 27, 2020 to decrease the risk of the spread of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19). In addition, the Prime Minister with the approval of the Cabinet, has declared the state of emergency in all areas in the Kingdom from March 26, 2020 to April 30, 2020 and invoked Section 9 under the Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation, B.E. 2548 to issue the regulation No.1 dated March 25, 2020 to further close the venues of risk areas.

In order for the university's operations to be effective and to comply with the additional measure to prevent COVID-19 crisis endorsed by the government, by virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Act B.E. 2541, the University has therefore issued this announcement with the following details:

- 1. The University announcement of Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak No.7 remains effective.
- 2. Amendment is made to Item 2. of the university's announcement on Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak No.7 to extend closure of the university until April 30, 2020.

Effective from now on until further announcement.
