



**Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi
Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak
No. 19
Screening and Control of Access to KMUTT Ratchaburi
for Students, Staff, Service Employees and Visitors**

Recently, Ministry of Interior sent an urgent Fax No. Mor Thor 0230/Vor 5246 dated September 8, 2020 to all involved agencies requesting tighter control along the border provinces with Myanmar to prevent illegal border crossing without health screening to Thailand. Every province and related agencies at every level are asked to coordinate their work in monitoring illegal immigrants travelling into Thailand and to notify the public and community of request for cooperation in surveilling and following the law and public health measures if meeting or finding any suspected individual.

The university is particularly concerned about the health of students, staff and service employees at King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT) Ratchaburi, which is considered a risky area, as it is close to the Myanmar border. In order to comply with the safety system and the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on the Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 3 and No. 4, by virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Act B.E. 2541 (1998), the university has issued the announcement with the following steps to be taken:

1. Students, staff and service employees of KMUTT Ratchaburi, who leave the university are asked to fill out the "Self-Declaration Form" every time they return to the university. Third parties or visitors who contact KMUTT Ratchaburi are requested to fill out the "Self-Declaration Form" as well.

The information is required by the surveillance measures in the risky area and it will help the university to properly implement safety and surveillance measures for at-risk groups.

2. Vice President Ratchaburi shall specify rigorous safety measures and establish screening measures to meet the standards that are suitable for the area, and communicate with students, personnel and service employees at all levels to strictly comply with the prevention measures for the spread of COVID-19.

3. Students, staff and service employees of KMUTT Ratchaburi, who have close contact with vulnerable groups, such as migrant workers are required to strictly follow the prevention measures of COVID-19 to ensure safety of themselves and society.

4. Students, staff and service employees of KMUTT Ratchaburi, who have a fever or experience respiratory abnormalities or anticipate COVID-19 patient/case (s) are requested to report the Department or immediate superiors, fill out “a Report of anticipating COVID-19 patient at KMUTT” at bit.ly/Wereport and visit health service providers according to their benefit scheme.

If there is any problem or issue arising from this announcement, President, Senior Vice President for Administrative Affairs, Vice President Ratchaburi and Director of Office of Building and Ground Management are tasked with deliberating and executing any action deemed appropriate.
