



**Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi  
Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak**

**No. 25**

**Student Activity Arrangement and Sports Activities**

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With reference to the announcement of Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI) regarding the Vigilant measures against the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 10 on January 27, 2021 as guidelines for the universities and institutions under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI) and the announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on the Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 24 dated February 28, 2021.

In order to allow smooth and efficient operations on the organization of student activities and sports activities for academic year 2020 and compliance with the additional measures to prevent crisis of COVID-19 outbreak of the government, by virtue of Section 27 of the University ACT B.E.2541 and the resolution of the Student Development Sub-Committee Meeting 1/2021 on February 24, 2021, the university has thus issued guidelines for conducting student activities during the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation. The details are as follows:

1. Projects or activities scheduled to be held in the academic year 2020 are encouraged to be conducted in an online format instead of mass gatherings. Small group activities can be organized in a form of in-person or hybrid event to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
2. In organizing or attending physical activities, students shall strictly comply with COVID-19 preventive measures prescribed by the government and regulations announced by the University.
3. Should there be any reason or need to organize any activity that requires mass gathering, the activity's organizer is requested to submit an activity proposal to the Vice President for Student Development as Supervisor of Student Activity for approval. The proposal must include (1) activity format; (2) detailed activity plan; and (3) COVID-19 preventive measures during organization of the activity. Once approved, the Vice President should report to the President accordingly.
4. When conducting student activities, organizers and participants shall comply with the following guidelines;


No.	Type of activity	Guidelines
4.1	Events for Entertainment/Contests/ Competitions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Concerts</li> <li>– Musical Performances</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– The events organized by KMUTT students which are allowed to be held on campus include Musical Performances, Thai traditional dances and cultural events.</li> <li>– The events must be conducted in open spaces with high air flow and participants must strictly follow COVID-19 preventive measures.</li> <li>– The number of participants must be considered according to an event venue size.</li> <li>– All sports activities are permitted to be conducted on campus including exercise and practice sessions as designated on the Guidelines for the Sports Fields and Exercise Areas Usage as attached.</li> <li>– Intramural sports and competitions can be conducted on campus; however, cheering team and audience are not allowed at the competition venue. The organizer can choose to conduct the competition in an alternative format as deemed appropriate and not against this Announcement. In case of participating in a competition organized by an external organization, students must request for written preventive measures for communicable disease from the event organizer as a supporting document for event participation approval.</li> </ul>
4.2	Sports and Recreation events <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Sports competition</li> <li>– Drum practice session/Cheer activity</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– The following recreation activities shall be suspended: drum sessions or practice sessions and all types of cheering activities.</li> </ul>
4.3	Social responsibility activities <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Volunteer camp/Rural development camp</li> <li>– Service activities</li> <li>– Facilities maintenance activities such as street painting, landscape improvement, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– All off-campus activities conducted in rural areas shall be suspended until further notice.</li> <li>– All activities are permitted to be held in Bangkok, provinces which are not listed as a highly controlled zone as well as within the university campuses (Bangmod, Bangkhuntien, Ratchaburi) and nearby surrounding area. The activity organizer must perform risk assessment and examine the COVID-19 situation of the area where the activity will be conducted. Long distance travel and overnight stay must be avoided.</li> </ul>

4.4	Academic activities <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Meetings, Seminars, Talk</li> <li>– Conference (Oral/Poster Presentation)</li> <li>– Academic Competition</li> <li>– Tutorial</li> <li>– Open House</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– All academic activities are to be conducted online. If it is necessary to be conducted on-site, the event must be conducted in the same manner as how to conduct in-class lectures.</li> <li>– In case of participating in an event organized by external organizations, students must request for written preventive measures for communicable disease from the event organizer as a supporting document for event participation approval.</li> </ul>
4.5	Religious Activities/ Religious Ceremonies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Merit-making activities such as offering food to the monks</li> <li>– Other religious activities/ ceremonies</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Religious activities are allowed to be organized on-campus but must strictly follow the COVID-19 preventive measure.</li> <li>– The number of participants must be considered according to the event venue size.</li> </ul>
4.6	Markets/Student Marketplaces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– The activity shall be suspended until further notice.</li> </ul>
4.7	Parties such as University party, Bye-noir party, Freshy Night party, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– All types of parties shall be suspended until further notice.</li> </ul>
4.8	Activities other than specified in this Announcement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– The University requests the organizer to postpone the event until further notice.</li> <li>– If there is an urgency to organize the activity, the organizer must contact Student Affairs Office for their consideration of the event venue and get an approval from the Vice President for Student Development and report to the President accordingly.</li> </ul>
4.9	University activities for students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– It is recommended to adjust the activity format either in the form of online activity, physical activity or hybrid activity as deemed appropriate. The organization of activity must not be against the preventive measures prescribed by the government and the regulations announced by the University.</li> </ul>

Any activities which have not yet been approved in the semester 2/2020, the permission to conduct those activities shall be considered by the University when COVID-19 situation gradually improves and must follow the measures prescribed by the government authorities.
